Gan Program Outline

The Gan Program at camp is designed for campers who are between preschool (18 months) through second grade. Gan staff is trained in working with campers within this age range and is able to provide age appropriate programming for those campers. Part of the programming day provides campers with the opportunity to get an age appropriate “taste” for our older camper programs.

A typical Gan Day programming day begins after breakfast and continue until lunch. Gan Campers eat lunch with their family, and programming resumes after lunch until dinner. Start with dinner through the evening the gan campers spend time with their family.

There may be a few times where Gan programming can be extended to include time before breakfast or after dinner, this will have to be approved by the Camp Director and Rosh Gan in order to ensure staff availability.

Please speak directly with them in order to arrange this if you are running a camp activity when Gan is not available and need Gan programming for that time.

We love having our Gan campers experience all that camp has to offer. However, there are areas where our Gan program needs explicit parent permission to take the Gan campers to. Registration Terms and conditions

Thank you for completing the registration for Camp Ramah in Northern California's Gan program. Please read the following legal disclaimer and Ramah policy acknowledgements carefully and sign on the bottom.

As required by the California Department of Human Services, we must have a completed medical form on file for each camper. Please complete and electronically sign your camper's Health History form and have your child's physician complete and sign the physician's form. The completed physician's form must be uploaded to your account along with an immunization history provided by the physician and a copy of your child's valid insurance card by March 15, 2018 or within 3 weeks if you register after February 28, 2018. Late or incomplete forms may jeopardize your child's ability to attend Camp Ramah in Northern California.

Please note that Camp Ramah in Northern California requires all campers to receive the full complement of routine vaccinations as recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) vaccinations in order to attend camp.

GENERAL TERMS

I understand that Camp Ramah in Northern California is run under the auspices of the National Ramah Commission (NRC) on facilities operated by Camp Ramah in Northern California in conjunction with Monterey Bay Academy (MBA). Camp Ramah in Northern California, NRC, and MBA are not responsible for my child's personal property.

I understand that activities at Camp Ramah in Northern California entail a level of risk. The Camp Ramah in Northern California campus is located along the ocean with wildlife, natural rock formations and running water. As part of the Camp Ramah in Northern California program, my child will have opportunities to explore parts of the camp and the surrounding area. Camp groups will embark on trips throughout Northern California. Any activity my child will engage in contains some element of risk. While employees and contractors of Camp Ramah in Northern California will do everything in their power to provide a safe experience, I agree to assume the risk for my child of injury or death caused by participation in any activities associated with his/her participation in the activities of Camp Ramah in Northern California except for any such injuries or damages which arise primarily from the gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct of any of the Camp Ramah in Northern California Parties. I further understand that part of the camping experience involves activities, group living arrangements, and interactions that may be new to my child. I realize that no environment is risk-free and so I have instructed my child on the importance of abiding by the camp's rules as outlined in the parents' handbook available for view on our website. My child and I both agree that he or she is familiar with these rules and will obey them.

I give permission for my child to participate in camp activities outside the camp's grounds as planned by the staff and approved by Camp Ramah in Northern California and, when allowed by outside vendors, I hereby authorize Camp Ramah in Northern California to sign liability waivers on my behalf for my child's participation in activities run by outside vendors selected by Camp Ramah in Northern California.

I understand that Camp Ramah in Northern California will not tolerate behaviors such as violence, possession of weapons, repeated profanity, disrespect, bigotry, inappropriate sexual behavior, drug and alcohol use, or any other unsafe behaviors that are potentially harmful to my child and/or others. The consequence of such behaviors can mean dismissal from camp with no tuition refund. I agree to discuss these expectations with my child.

INDEMNITY AND MISCELLANEOUS

I agree to release, indemnify and hold harmless NRC, Camp Ramah in Northern California, and MBA for any claims that might arise as a result of the use of the campus or participation in activities on the campus including any claim asserted by my child after he/she becomes an adult, with the exception of any claims or damages that arise primarily from any gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct by Ramah in Northern California Parties. I acknowledge that I am signing freely and voluntarily, and intend my electronic signature to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability, with the exception of liability for gross negligence or willful or wanton misconduct.

I agree that any dispute or cause of action arising between Camp Ramah in Northern California Parties and me, whether out of this agreement or otherwise, can only be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in California, and shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the state of California.

I authorize Camp Ramah in Northern California, National Ramah Commission, as well as its unnamed affiliates and partner organizations to use photos and video images of my child as well as any written and verbal correspondence, created by campers or their family members for publicity or fundraising purposes unless I specify otherwise.

The information on the camper application is true and accurate. I understand that enrollment is subject to approval by Camp Ramah in Northern California.

Space at Camp Ramah in Northern California will be reserved only on the basis of completed applications including deposit and availability of space in a child's age group at camp.
